d. Treasurer report

Costs of events are being covered. Run rates for Hall Bookings and Events are being reviewed. We continue to have a prudent reserve. Priorities for spend for the coming months include securing the Store with replacement doors and some rewiring needs connected to the bar.

e. Maintenance, Building Facilities, Heath & Safety, and Risk Assessment Actions / News

Anthony is leading the Bar Facilities which are coming along nicely. In January we will review planting needs for the boundary in the garden.
